## MATCH DIRECTORS REPORT

March 2nd Championship Series Match  
Nolan Smyth MD

As a first time Match Director I was more than just a little nervous about the match and the weather forecasts didn't help much. After a sleepless night listening to the rain come and go, we had 50 shooters sign up Sunday morning, with 16 of them shooting Limited class. Fortunately at the last minute the weather decided to cooperate and was just beautiful.

I want to thank all the people who came out Saturday and helped set up the stages: Ray and Russ Wakida, Steve Wong, Randy Melton, Johnny Lim, Elson Low, Gene Shuey, Randy Coates, Doug Wing, Steve Sui, and my brother Gene Smyth (who will be your next sacrifice, err Match Director.) I also want to thank Russ Wakida again for his cooperation and understanding when I had to make a last second (10a.m. Sunday) change to his stage. Thanks to Ebert Kan doing sign ups, & Wesley Lew doing stats the match ran very smoothly in spite of me running around like the proverbial decapitated poultry.

Stage 1 was named "Steve's Butt Ray's" which was designed by Steve Wong who gives credit (or was that blame) to Ray Wakida for building it. It was a 33 round field course starting with the loaded gun laying on a table. After retrieving the gun and moving into the first box 3 targets were engaged. Then 3 more targets were engaged from a barricade, one on the left & two on the right. Of course a no-shoot or two made it sound a lot easier than it was. After crying over the no-shoots 6 poppers were engaged under a moderately low port, which evoked more groans when the poppers refused to stand still long enough to be knocked down. Then while on the move in a longish shooting box 3 more paper targets were engaged before ending at the last 4 targets engaged through a window. Russ Wakida won the stage with his patented fast & smooth style down only 4 points in 22.70 seconds. Randy Melton was second for first Master. Johnny Lim was first A with a screaming time of 21.18 seconds but a 10 point penalty moved him down to fifth. Max Flora was first B, Elson Low was first C and Kevin Weller was first Limited.

Stage 2 was Randy Melton and Johnny Lim's "Sh\*t load of Steel" which Randy designed in case it rained. It started out as a 46 round field course, but when I put the new targets up Sunday morning I forgot one, so it ended up at 44 rounds. The shooter started out sitting behind a table with the loaded gun laying on the table. Boy this is saving a lot of wear and tear on my holster. At the signal the shooter picked up the gun and engaged 3 poppers, one paper target and one steel plate waaayyy out there at about 25 yards. We found out who's guns were zeroed pretty quickly. One of the poppers activated a swinger mounting a pair of no-shoots which made for a fun time shooting around the barricade at 2 poppers and one paper target. Then a mad dash clear across the bay to a really low port to engage 4 US poppers. After the medics applied the back and knee braces it was on to a doorway to engage, you guessed it more poppers and one paper target that was all hardcover except for the upper A/B zone. Then back across the range to a wall with 4 small ports, thankfully none much lower than my belt buckle, to engage 5 paper targets. Moving around the corner of the wall 3 paper targets were engaged from way around the right side of a barricade then 3 more targets were engaged from waaayyy around the left side of a second barricade. Russ Wakida beat everybody by 5 seconds and only dropped 7 points. Second was Johnny Lim taking first A. Rod Maeda was first Master way back in forth. Rick Theilen was first B, and Elson Low was first C. Kevin Weller proved his gun was sighted in as

first Limited.

Stage 3 was built by Russ Wakida originally as a 52 round hose festival, but unfortunately had to be trimmed back to 43 rounds. (If you like the idea of 50+ round stages, be sure and let the Board of Directors know!) The shooter started with hands at sides, gun loaded and holstered (I knew I wore that thing for a reason.) At the signal 2 paper targets about 20 yards away were engaged through a doorway. Then after going through the door 4 poppers and 3 plates were engaged. Moving on to a port 3 targets were engaged amidst a couple of no-shoots. Then in a small open area beside the port some old tires were stacked up blocking a pair of the next 4 targets. Several people found the tires a bit tougher than they looked and suffered misses when the tires swallowed up their bullets. After a little lateral dash 2 targets were engaged through a pair of ports, or if you were tall enough and brave enough, through a single port. Of course a no-shoot kept getting in the way. Around the corner 2 more targets were engaged before crossing a fault line to engage the last targets through a side window. Rod Maeda won this stage and scored extra style points for making each steel plate spin a full circle before falling. Alex Potter took first A. Max Flora was again first B. Glenn Mingoa was first C and John Daudet was first Limited.

Stage 4 was built by Gene Smyth and was aptly named "Bonus Shots?" Starting from a seated position, hands on knees, feet in box A, the shooter engaged a pair of disappearing targets that were mostly hardcover and a pair of poppers that released the disappearing targets. Moving into shooting area B 4 paper targets were engaged around a gaggle of no-shoots. From window C which was a pretty good stretch, one paper and 4 steel plates were engaged. Moving around the window 4 targets were engaged up close and personal from shooting area D. Then the last 4 targets were engaged through some stinking slats (we don't need no stinking slats!) Russ again was stage winner, followed by Paul Ghent for first Master. Wade (makes the ground shake) Lundgren was right on their heels to take first A. Arthur Vizcarra was first B and Elson Low was first C. John Daudet was first Limited.

The Classifier was XMAS and was built by ME, okay, okay. Gene Smyth built the props, I just measured it out and stapled up the targets. This was an 18 round, remind me it's Virginia Count stage. A large upright equilateral triangle (didn't think I knowed them big words did ya?) had a 4 foot square of plywood nailed in the middle to form 3 shooting ports at the triangles points. 30 feet away 3 paper targets were mostly covered up with a single no-shoot and Boy was there a lot of tape on that no-shoot at the end of the day. The procedure was pretty straight forward. Standing with both hands on the plywood, at the signal the shooter drew and engaged the 3 targets with 2 rounds each, made a mandatory reload and moved to a different port. The targets were reengaged with 2 rounds each, another mandatory reload and the targets were engaged again from the last port. Paul Ghent took the stage win. Ray Wakida was first A. Walter Hashimoto was first B, and Glenn Mingoa was first C. Howard Holzer was first Limited.

The final scores were entered and the results were out by 5 pm before a minor data entry error was discovered. A circled miss on one of the disappearing targets had been entered as a straight miss, so the scores were recalculated. Sorry Ray but your brother Russ was still the Match winner. Dan Ruff was second overall for first Master, Paul Ghent was second Master, and Randy Melton was third Master. Ray Wakida was first A, Johnny Lim was second A, and Alex Potter was third A. Max Flora took first B, Rick Theilen was second B, and Carl (I love my new Jeep) Roessler was third B. Elson Low was first C, and Glenn Mingoa was second C. Joe Keipert took first Unclassified. Kevin Weller was first Limited, John Daudet was second Limited, and Tim Shaver

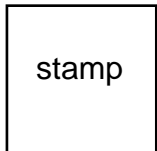
