NOTES FROM THE IPSC RANGE CHAIRMAN

The Hot Shots first general membership meeting in several years was held at noon at the December championship series match. The purpose of this meeting was to update info on the state of the club and to garner volunteers for the 1999 Golden Gate Championship. Sufficient people came forward to make the commitment to the match, hence it is scheduled for August 27-29, 1999.

A little history is in order. The Hot Shots were formed circa 1985 by Stu Mullins and a few others who had decided to move from BAPSL at Chabot. There are just a few people left from that time who are still shooting with us: Dave Antonini, Ebert Kan, Carl Roessler, Dan Ruff, Wayne Leong, Dave Uchida, Rich Wilbur, & Angelo Spagnoli are the only active Hot Shots who were shooting at Richmond prior to my arrival to the IPSC range in mid 1988 (Please excuse anyone omitted due to my senior moments). I had shot with BAPSL during the early 80's but had taken a few years off to concentrate on high power. Stu Mullins was prez of the Hot Shots when I arrived; I knew Stu from BAPSL--he had been winning everything when I stopped in 1984 and was still doing that four years later. Stu retired from active IPSC sometime during 1990 and we held a special election which resulted in Dave Antonini as prez and me as VP. Dave chose not to run again and in January 1991 I was narrowly chosen to run the Hot Shots. That election for 1991 was the last meaningful election which was held by the Hot Shots. I was reelected running unopposed for the next three years, and we never had more than 1 or 2 candidates more than the "board" required. We never had opposition for any of the offices. In December 1994 an election for an at large board was held. This was repeated for 1995 and 1996. No election was held in 1997 or 1998. There just wasn't sufficient interest to have an election. In 1997 the Richmond Rod and Gun Club Board of Directors changed the name of the Hot Shots Board to Hot Shots Committee (there should only be one board at the club) and that's takes things pretty much up to the present.

Together with the Chief Range Officers I

have appointed the following five people to serve as the new Hot Shots Match Committee: John Daudet, Wesley Lew, Alex Potter, Dan Ruff, and Alan Samuel. These five along with me and the CRO's (Dave Antonini, Ebert Kan, Rod Maeda, and Carl Roessler) will conduct the pre match safety walk through and make other decisions regarding the administration of the matches. This format will be used for calendar 1999 and will be addressed next fall to ascertain whether it will be more permanent. There will be general membership meetings in June and December of 1999.

Richmond hosted its first Glock Shooting Sports Foundation Match the weekend before Thanksgiving. 161 courses of fire were shot during the two days of the match. Some people shot in more than one category, but there were nearly 140 in attendance. All involved were pleased with the match and we have committed to holding another next year the 3rd weekend in September 1999.

GSSF sponsors 25 matches during the year which are held countrywide. This year 3 matches were held in California and Richmond will be the site for future northern California matches. There are three courses of fire which are relatively simple for experience IPSC people, hence the match draws many novices. There is no movement, no draws, and no reloads in order to keep it simple and safe.

All shooters are welcome; the only requirement is that one must shoot a Glock pistol in order to compete.
