Up early Sunday and drove home in the rain but no problemo. It did snow in Bakersfield the next night, but we missed it by 24 hours. Now that would have been a trip--my first 3-gun on snowshoes. Maybe next year.

**The Amnesia Bowl or: Why Joe Solano is in my Hall of Fame January 3, 1999**

Sunday dawned clear and bright, and I headed for the range confident that the all-star group of CRO's I had recruited at the December open match would already have assembled five challenging (and sadistic) courses of fire.

At 7:00 A.M. I drove in to find the gates open and Joe Solano setting up stage 1. Joe was not the CRO I had recruited, but was there to cover for the original 'volunteer.' Perhaps that and the early hour accounted for the edge in his "what double?" course, which among other touches included twelve head shots and some long-range charmers at partially covered targets. The classifier, "Payne's Pain," was one of those nasty little exercises of twelve rounds, won handily by Frank Cruz, Jr., with Steve Wong and Adam Carlson trailing.

Stage 2's name was NOT my creation. "Where the hell is Brian" was, however, my early morning dyspepsia coming out. Starting at a table, shooters moved left behind a barrier line engaging clusters of steel through barrels; when they reached the other end, they returned along the barrier line engaging clusters of paper targets through other barrels. The course did involve a little bit of exercise accompanied by some loud groaning. Frank Cruz, Jr., Ebert Kan and Wesley led the field.

Louis Cambre designed Stage 3, "Looks like fun to me!" The stage began with three paper targets at 30 yards, but the farther into the course you went the closer and faster everything got. Lots of fun indeed, with Frank Cruz, Jr., James Ochoa and Steve Wong nimbly leading the pack.

Stage 4, "Please, no jam!" did not refer to the fruit spread on your morning bagel. This was close-up blazing as crafted by Ken Hashimoto and Steve Wong. Steel and paper targets whizzed by as you raced past windows and down corridors. Neat! James Ochoa streaked through in 21.96, followed closely by Adam Carlson and Steve Wong.

In open class, Jams Ochoa was our overall winner, with Adam Carlson at 96.39% and Frank Cruz, Jr. At 95.49%

Limited class was led by Rodger Walther, with Michael Boyd at 95.33%.

Adam Carlson was first Grand Master, Frank Cruz, Jr. Was first Master, Steve Wong first A, David Ponce first B and David Webb first in C class.

A footnote: about halfway through the match I went into the stats shack and found Joe Solano entering stats. "Where's Ebert?" I said. "He's the stats RO for this match." "I don't know," Joe answered. "I just saw that nobody was doing it so I thought I should."

That, folks, is why I called the match "The Amnesia Bowl," and that is why our club owes so much to responsible members like Joe Solano.
