## December Limited Series Match Report

Crisp was the order of the day from the weather to the shooting. 36 hooters came out for a great match which featured five fast and furious, shoot and scoot, hose down stages. The match was over by 7:15 pm allowing all competitors the chance to be in the man on man hootoffs originally scheduled only for the Top 16. Even so, we were done with everything and in the bar by 4:00 pm!

My thanks to the CRO crew of Elson Low, Doug Wing, Kevin Weller, Al Jung, Dan Ruff and Russ Wakida. Thanks also to Steve Vong, Rod Maeda, Ray Wakida, Ken Hashimoto, Joe Solano, Gene Huey, Royce High, (get this name!) Gene Kelly and David Webb or their invaluable assistance in running a very successful match.

Stage One: CROs Elson Low and Doug Wing setup the USPSA Classifier "Shoot-and-Move" which consisted of three boxes, barricades and a combination of paper and two poppers. Russ won his stage with Kevin Weller taking First C and Randy Coates taking First D.

Stage Two: CRO Kevin Weller w/ assistance from Steve Wong setup his quickie stage on Range 1.5 which included movement, steel and barricades. I can't emphasize enough how difficult it is to do something interesting on this range because it is so narrow, but these guys did it well. Russ won this one too, with Al Jung taking first B and Royce High taking High Unclassified.

Stage Three: CRO Al Jung w/ assistance from Rod Maeda setup a blazing hose down which featured a lot of movement through tunnels and corridors and fast open targets. Dave Uchida won this stage with Steve Wong at first C and Dean Nishimura grabbing first D.

Stage Four: CRO Dan Ruff w/ assistance from Ray Wakida recreated recent Nationals stage featuring a quick start on open paper and two poppers then a fast house clearing. Hosemonster Russ won with an incredible hit factor of 10.7977! Jon Ng took first C and Russell piker took High Unclassified.

Stage Five: CRO Russ Wakida setup a fast and fun stage which consisted of move and shoots, ports and angles. Dispelling the myth that you crash on your own stage, Russ won this one with Ben Terrama earning High A and David Webb at High Unclassified.

A man on man shoot off was setup for all wished to play. The hoot off was on alternating poppers and US poppers. The single elimination format evened out the field and the results proved that you can't miss fast enough to win as several upsets were recorded. It came down to the two best shooters of the day, Russ and Rod, best two out of three. Rod took the first run with a clean, smooth run. They switched sides and Russ tied it up with one of his own. It came down to one run for all the marbles and as both shooters hammered multiple shots on their last poppers, Russ's squeaked by adding the hoot off win to his match win.
